- ◆ Warren Newhauser of Mill Creek Systems will present a solution currently under development to create an index for large raster drawings such as maps, facilities plans, service records, schematics, etc. in order to make them "Google" searchable. The vision is that the engineers, planners, etc. should be able to do basic searches on scanned drawings without having to open individual drawings, which can be time consuming.
- ◆ Scott Hand of Integrys/Wisconsin Public Service (WPS) will discuss his organization's SIAS Real Estate Application. The WPS real estate department had a need to tie real estate legal documents (easements, deeds, leases) to a map location. Learn how this requirement was met through the implementation of an intranet map viewing application which allows users to simultaneously view data originating in Smallworld, ESRI, and the Livelink document management system.
- ◆ Dave Davis of the City of Madison's Public Works Department will highlight the benefits and difficulties of implementing a variety of different spatial technologies to address Madison's business needs.
- ◆ Brian Jensen of GeoDecisions will present a unique and very successful GIS application implemented for the City of New York that utilizes geospatial technology for an age-old problem. Don't miss the presentation of the Rat Information Portal - a one-stop resource website for New Yorkers' rat prevention needs.
